## Additional Information

### Directions to free parking & shuttle:

- From I-64/I-77 take Exit 99 (Greenbrier St./State Capitol) and turn right onto Greenbrier Street. Stay in right lane and turn right at next light onto Washington Street. At next light turn right on Elizabeth Street. Immediately after crossing railroad tracks look for Visitor Parking area to the left (adjacent to University of Charleston stadium).
- You can walk to the Main Capital Building or wait at bus stop on the other side of the street for the Shuttle bus. The shuttle is free and makes continuous trips all day between the parking area and the capitol for visitors.
